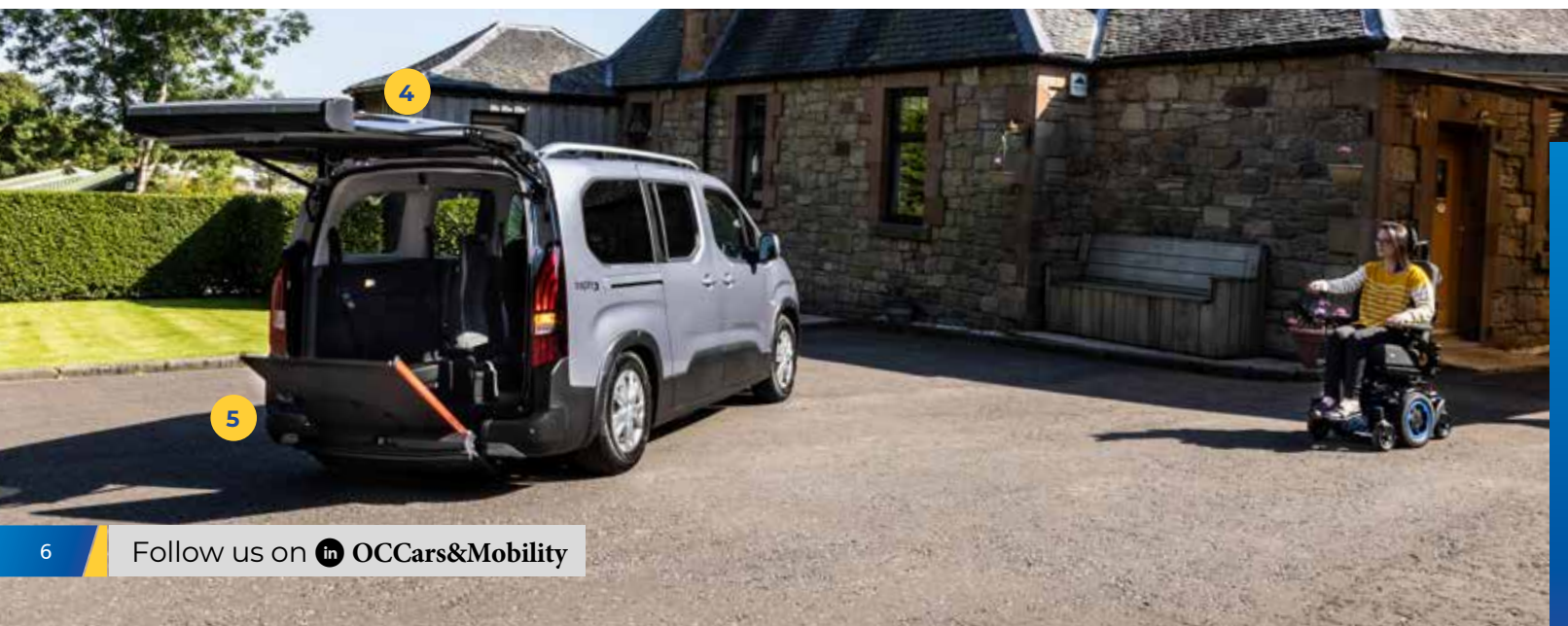

A Drive-From WAV (DFW) is a specially designed vehicle which enables you to drive from your wheelchair.

By removing and stowing the original driver seat, space is created for your manual or powered wheelchair.

Using a handy key fob, your tailgate is opened automatically which releases your low-gradient wheelchair ramp, allowing you to enter your Drive-From WAV safely from the rear of the vehicle. Once inside, you'll find superb visibility and an automatic safety system to secure your chair in place.

With the original Peugeot front passenger seat easily removed, a wheelchair or powerchair can enter by the rear access ramp and move right up to the forward position. An independent automatic safety system or four-point tie downs can be used to secure your chair in place, alongside a full lap and diagonal seatbelt, ensuring a safe and comfortable journey.

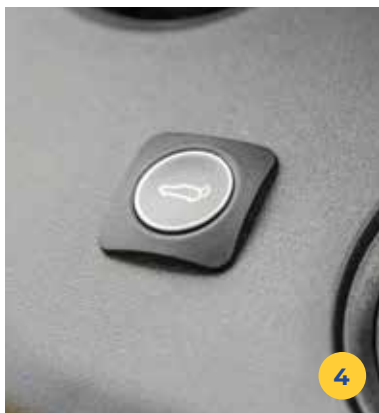
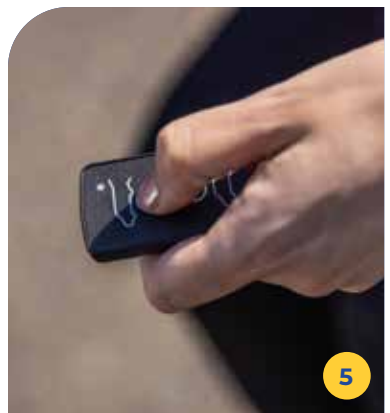
